STORAGE INSTRUCTIONS

Store in a cool dry place. Close container after use.

COMPOSITION

■ WARNINGS

- · Do not feed to laying or breeding hens, turkeys, horses or other equines. Ingestion by horses can be fatal.
- . Birds must not be slaughtered for human consumption during treatment or for at least 5 days after the last treatment.
- Birds should not be treated with products containing tiamulin for at least 7 days before or after receiving feed containing this
 product. Severe growth depression or death may result.
- Do not leave or dispose of VIRBACOX, or feed containing it, where it may be accessible to animals not under treatment, or to wildlife.
- · Handle with care. Poisonous when swallowed.
- Keep out of reach of children, uninformed persons and animals.
- Although this remedy has been extensively tested under a large variety of conditions, failure thereof may ensue as a result of
 a wide range of reasons. If this is suspected, seek veterinary advice and notify the registration holder.

■ Precautions:

- Operators should avoid direct contact with the product or inhalation.
- · Wear face masks to at least the specification of BS 2091, impervious gloves and protective overalls when handling.
- · Rinse eyes thoroughly with water immediately if contact with eyes occurs.
- Medicated feed must be used within 3 months of mixing.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Use only as directed

- Mix 450 g to 550 g VIRBACOX per ton of complete feed to supply 54 to 66 mg / kg Salinomycin sodium.
- Normal dosage rate is 500 g per ton providing 60 mg / kg of Salinomycin sodium.
